Library Presentations:

- Abigail presented the library operations and functions by staff, Library Advisory Board, Teen Library Council (TLC), New Friends of BCL, and The Foundation. The groups discussed three questions: What did you learn that surprised you? How can we best collaborate? How can we best communicate?
- The Management Team Michele Caldwell - Technical Services, Victoria Campbell – Youth Services, Linda Fallon – Adult Reference, Jennifer Johnson – Volunteer Program and Melissa Little - Circulation presented a show-and-tell of their library divisions.

Teen Library Council (TLC): by Nikki Kolpakov – TLC Liaison

- The mission of TLC is to develop and support teens in grades 6 – 12 and assist with youth library programs. Currently, they are working on the annual Poetry Coffeehouse scheduled on Thursday, April 27, 6 – 7:30 p.m. at BCL-Main. Poetry winners will be announced at the event. TLC submitted a video to a statewide competition for teen library councils. This year's video theme is "Build a Better World."

Beaverton Library Foundation:

- Erin Wooley gave a brief background of how The Foundation provides funding for library activities and services including the Summer Reading Program. The fundraiser New Year's Party "Loud in the Library" raised \$20,000; and had 400 attendees. They also sponsor college scholarships to high school students. This year's winner is Juliáe Riva.

New Friends of the Library:

- Ray Grant distributed a handout of Friends 2016 Revenue showing the breakdown of book sales. The Book Corner re-opened on Tuesday, April 4, along with a grand reopening party on Saturday, April 8. Their new hours are Tuesday – Saturday, 11 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
