Read and Approve Minutes of October 11, 2017, Meeting:

- Chair Gautam Kottapalli called for the approval of the October 11 minutes as amended. Maureen Inouye-Harrison moved and Brad Schrock seconded the motion. Nancy Nkiwane abstained. It was approved by the Board members.

- The City of Beaverton Holiday Open House & Tree Lighting will be held on Saturday, December 2, from 4 – 6 p.m. Library volunteers will be distributing used books to all children attending the event.
- Abigail asked the Board to "Save the Date" for Boards & Commissions Dinner scheduled on Thursday, December 7. Abigail will send invitations to TLC members who attend our board meetings.

- Friends raised \$11,300 from their annual book sale in October.
- Friends will donate \$50,000 to the library before the end of 2017. The Advisory Board will be asked to approve this donation at their next meeting.
- The Friends board is working in the next phase in improving the Book Corner property, including raising/moving the sign, considering additional storage, and adding more gravel to the driveway area.
- Tom Cutts has joined the Friends board. Tom previously served as chair of the Library Advisory Board.

Teen Library Council (TLC): by Nikki Kolpakov, TLC Liaison

TLC welcomed new members in September and developed groups focusing on Marketing, Latino, and Board meetings. TLC's goal is to present one big event and one smaller event each month starting in 2018.

The following events were held or being offered this winter:

- Haunted *Gingerdead* House, October 24.
- 15th Annual Teen Art Show, November 9–12, 198 art pieces received by 138 local teen artists!
- Tree Lighting, December 2, hosting children's crafts

Old Business:

- WCCLS has a number of projects planned for FY17-18. Abigail gave a short summary of the following projects:
 - Improved online event calendar;
 - Special library card for youth
 - Option to pay library fines online with a credit card

 - Online tutoring through BrainFuse
 - Emergency management planning for libraries
 - Discovery layer interface for WCCLS website and online catalog
