Approval of Minutes from March 13, 2019 Meeting:

New Friends of the Beaverton City Library: Maureen Inouye-Harrison reported that the Friends will be holding their spring book and media sale from April 10-14, which will also include jigsaw puzzles, thanks to a generous donation.

Teen Council Report: Areebah Zaidi reported that the Teen Council is working on a video contest, recently completed a Skittles mural, that they held programs during Spring Break, that there is a poetry contest in late April, they will have a table at the Farmer's Market this summer, that they will be recruiting new members in July, that Ann Moorhead and Jamison Hanson will be at the next LAB meeting, during which they will show the video.

- Glenn Ferdman passed out copies of the Library's proposed FY2019-20 budget and responded to questions from LAB members. John suggested LAB members review the budget and come prepared with additional questions next month.
- John led a discussion about feedback regarding the Library's new hours.
