New Business

- **Strategic Plan:** Community survey was launched through the Beaverton Engage platform. In the first few weeks, more than 1,600 people have responded.
- **Cross training:** Circulation and Access staff has begun to assist with Technical Services work, as available staff bandwidth allows.
- **Fall Volunteer Appreciation Event:** Alicia, along with Sandy C., Sandy R., and Megan, hosted a festive volunteer appreciation event at Main on Nov. 12. More than 30 volunteers and their guests enjoyed activities like squeegee postcard crafting and decorating bookmarks, along with taking home a special 3D printed coaster.

- **Library on Wheels Sites:** Lets parents know that we visit their children once a month at their childcare. It included evening and weekend storytime information, with a link to our Strategic Plan survey.
- **BSD Student Library Card Project:** Completed 14 schools in November. Cards were mailed to 8 schools that were visited by Jillian on the Bookmobile route or Jennifer W. and Araceli at Kindergarten classes in November. Golden Ticket books and Wallace pouches were put out at reference desks for prize pickup.
- **Project Homeless Connect One Day:** Event in Tigard on Nov. 7. They interacted with 285 people, gave away 55 kids and teen books, and connected people with library and city services.
- **Community Bookshelf:** We started a Community Bookshelf at the new Beaverton Recovery Center.
